THREE-WAY TIE IN THE NON-PRO CLASSIC/CHALLENGE 2ND GO! GILLOCK, TAYLOR & PEACOCK SHARE TOP SPOT

In the second go-round of the Non-Pro Classic Challenge Tuesday, the high score was had by three horse and rider teams, each who delivered a 215.5 run. Jill Peacock, of Texas and Woody Be Tuff; Theresa Gillock, Las Vegas, Nevada on Dual Whisper; and Tracy Taylor, Yuba City, California all shared the 2nd go-round lead. "It's always nice when a run comes together like that...your horse feels good and the cows are hard but your horse is just gritty and handles them," said Gillock of her run on the six-year-old daughter of Kit Dual. "I studied the cattle and watched the herd real close and watched the cutters that rode before me. Then, I just went in and cut with a lot of feel."

In contrast, Tracy Taylor, who rode Ginny Flynn in the class, said he relied on California trainer, Gavin Jordan, to pick his cattle...then went to the herd and cut. "I didn't watch the cattle. I just got my horse ready and when I walked in the pen Gavin told me to just go cut shape, which is something I usually never do at an aged event...I will at the weekend shows, but at an event like this I will usually pick my cattle." Taylor's second-go run, he felt, was a bit of a survival test. "In the first go, the mare was just really, really good...but I didn't cut quite as good as I would have liked. The horse just

DAVID ANDERSEN RETAINS COMPOSITE LEAD

After marking a 206 in the first round, MaryAnn Rapp of Weatherford, Texas, came back tough in the second go-round of the Non-Pro Cutting Stakes, marking a 215.5 that earned her and Tootsie Rey that round's top score. The mare by Dual Rey and Rapp turned in a gritty run that advanced them into the final round.

The overall composite high score went to David Andersen and CD Peptophilly thanks to their 214 run that garnered the composite lead with a 430 in the class that took a 418 to advance.

really took care of me,” he said. “Today was more survival. Everyone comes here with great horses...it’s the cattle that get you to the finals. In the set today, I could tell by how many riders were walking out that it wasn’t going to be easy.” He added, “I just paid a lot of attention to time management.”

Jill Peacock, who couldn’t be reached for comment, rode her good stallion Woody Be Tuff, by Nitas Wood, to the third matching 215.5 for the go-round lead.

Kittens and Bonnie Martin advanced to the Finals in the composite lead position with a 432, after marking a 212 in the second go-round. The final competition in this class will take place on Saturday.
