50k Amateur

THREE-YEAR-OLD RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. For three-year-olds (foals of 2013) all breeds. All entrants must be designated a \$50,000 Amateur Rider by NCHA rules and records.
- 2. \$5,000 added purse.
- 3. Nomination fee:

Payment Due Sept 5, 2016*\$927 *includes \$378 Entry Fee, \$392 cattle charge, \$135 P/C**, \$12 video charge & \$10 Turnback Stall Fee

- Rider may enter both the Unlimited Amateur and \$50,000 Amateur and only pay the cattle charge for the Unlimited Amateur
- 4. Entries are taken and processed per PCCHA Aged Event Entry Rules.
- 5. The \$50,000 Amateur Futurity will be one go and a finals. The top scoring 30% (with a minimum of 8 and a maximum of 20) will advance to the finals. In the event there are less than 20 horses, there will be a pencil finals (non-working) after the go round(s) and no separate finals. Horses that mark a 0 or a 180 will not advance to the finals. All horses will go clean to the finals.
- 6. Three (3) head of cattle will be used in the go-round and four (4) in the finals.
- 7. If there are any ties for the championship of a Pacific Coast Event, the purse will be distributed 50/50. A work off will be held *only* to determine the recipient of the awards, if the competitors should chose.
- 8. Skyline Buckles will be awarded to the Champion and Reserve Champion.
- 9. **\$25,000 Amateur, Gelding & Sr Divisions:** There will be a \$25,000 Amateur, Gelding & Sr (55 yrs & Older) Divisions within the Futurity \$50,000 Amateur Division. (Earnings level for \$25,000 determined by lifetime NCHA earnings.) Entry Fees for the \$25,000 Amateur, Gelding & Sr Division jackpots will be \$500 (\$400 jackpot/\$100 office) due on Sept 15, 2016. Payouts will be in order of advancement according to NCHA Payout Schedule.
- 10. The PCCHA Executive Committee reserves the right should it be deemed necessary, to make any changes or alterations to the above rules.
- 11. All Owners and Riders must be current members of PCCHA and NCHA to compete.
