

INTERMEDIATE OPEN

This is how it works

1. The Intermediate Open Go Round runs within the 2nd Go Round of the Open. Therefore, you can enter a horse right up until the draw of the 2nd Go Round of the Open.
2. A horse can only be drawn in the 2nd Go one time. (He cannot go as an Open and an Intermediate horse under 2 separate riders.) He can be entered into the Intermediate with a 2nd rider if he does not make the 2nd go round with the original Open rider.
3. If a horse is entered in both the Open and Intermediate with the same rider...the 2nd go round score counts for the Open 2nd score and the Intermediate 1st score.
4. Upon completion of the 2nd go round the top 20% of the Intermediate and the Open will advance to their separate finals.
5. PCCHA rules state that in order to have a class Finals there must be 20 horses entered into the class.

Therefore, horses may be entered into the Intermediate Open up to 30 minutes of the conclusion of the 1st Open Go Round. At which time we will close entries and prepare to draw the 2nd Go Round.

Fees: \$ 950 - Intermediate horse that is already entered into the Open Draw

\$1,250 - Intermediate horse entering the Intermediate only
