



2019 PCCHA Stallion Service Auction & Subscribed Stallion Cutting Stakes Program

Stallion owners will be asked to donate a breeding annually for the PCCHA Stallion Service Auction, if they miss the auction, they may directly nominate their stallion to make all their 4-year-old offspring eligible to compete in the Open and Non Pro Cutting Stakes held during the PCCHA Futurity annually. Stallion must be nominated annually to make foals eligible for each breeding year.

1) Donate a breeding to the PCCHA Stallion Service Auction – breeding must sell for a minimum of \$1,000 to make the stallion fully nominated to the program and all foals eligible. Starting bid will begin at 50% of the advertised stud fee or \$500, whichever is greater. If stallion sells short of the \$1,000, the stallion owner will need to pay the difference to make their stallion fully nominated and all foals eligible for the breeding year. If the stallion owner decides not to pay the difference, the stallion will not be subscribed and offspring will not be eligible for the Cutting Stakes. If the breeding does not sell, then the stallion owner will be offered the opportunity to purchase the breeding within seven (7) days of close of auction for \$1,000 to make the stallion eligible and one of their foals then eligible for the Mare Owner Incentive. If the stallion owner does not wish to purchase the breeding within the 7 days, then the offspring will not be eligible for the Cutting Stakes unless nominated by paying the Subscription Fee later.

2) Directly Subscribe to the Stakes program for 50% of advertised stud fee or \$2,000, whichever is greater, and make all foals eligible for breeding year. Stallion owners will have up until August 1st of 4 year old year to nominate their stallion to make their offspring eligible.

Additional incentives beyond offspring eligibility for Stakes, for those who donate a breeding to the auction:

Stallion Owner Auction Incentive:

Stallion owners that donate to the auction will be eligible for the **\$6,000** Stallion Owner Auction Incentive purse paid out as follows to the stallion owner of the sire of the farthest advancing offspring in the **Futurity Open (\$3,000), Non Pro (\$2,000) and Unlimited Amateur (\$1,000)**. Monies paid to the Stallion owner(s), of record, at time of breeding and mare conception. If there are no eligible offspring in either the Futurity Open, Non Pro or Unlimited Amateur, no monies will be paid.

Cutting Stakes Stallion Owner Incentive:

Ten percent (10%) to stallion owner's purse for the Cutting Stakes (4 yr olds). The owners of the stallions siring the winners of the Cutting Stakes will receive ten percent (10%) of the total stallion subscription fees to be divided between the open and non-professional division in direct proportion to the number of entries in each division. Two places shall be paid in both the open and non-pro divisions. Stallion owner's purse shall be paid to the person(s) who paid the nomination fee.

Mare Owner Incentive:

Mare owners that purchase from the auction will be eligible for the \$6,000 Mare Owner Incentive purse paid out to the farthest advancing Futurity Open (\$3,000), Non Pro (\$2,000) and Unlimited Amateur (\$1,000) entries resulting from a PCCHA Stallion Service Auction breeding. Monies paid to the Stallion owner(s), of record, at time of breeding and mare conception. If there are no eligible offspring in either the Futurity Open, Non Pro or Unlimited Amateur, no monies will be paid.



1. Stallions that sell for \$1,000 or more in the PCCHA Stallion Service Auction or pay the subscription fee will make all of their offspring eligible for the Cutting Stakes for the year they are nominating (i.e. – nominate for foals of 2020, eligible to compete in 2024 in the Open and Non Pro Cutting Stakes at the PCCHA Futurity)
2. A Minimum bid of 50% of the advertised breeding fee or **\$500; whichever is greater**, will be required for each Stallion donating their service
3. Stallion Owner may purchase their own breeding at a minimum of **\$1,000** and in turn make their stallion and one of their own foals eligible for current incentives.
4. Stallions that miss the PCCHA Stallion Service Auction may Subscribe their stallion by paying 50% of the advertised stud fee for that breeding year, or \$2,000, whichever is greater, to make that foal crop eligible to compete for the Cutting Stakes Purse.
5. Breedings donated and purchased through the PCCHA Stallion Service Auction will be eligible for the PCCHA Stallion Owner Auction Incentive and Mare Owner Incentive that will be paid to the highest advancing 3-year-olds in the Open, Non Pro and Unlimited Amateur Futurity at the PCCHA Futurity.
6. Auction & Subscription fee distribution: Twenty percent (20%) of all stallion nomination fees shall be deducted for advertising and operations. The balance of the stallion nomination fees each year shall become the purse for the event to be distributed as follows: Eighty percent (80%) of the added money will go to the Cutting Stakes purse and Stallion and Mare Owner Incentives. The purse shall be divided between the Open and Non-Pro divisions in direct proportion to the number of entries in each division.



PCCHA Subscribed Stallion Program – (Revised 2018)

I. STALLION ELIGIBILITY

Any stallion of any breed may be nominated to the Pacific Coast Cutting Horse Association Subscribed Stallion Program. Upon payment of the appropriate nomination fees, the following offspring shall be eligible to show in the Stakes events.

- a. Four-year-old offspring of any stallion nominated
- b. Stallions must be nominated on or before deadline listed below in order for offspring to be eligible.
- c. Stallions will become eligible by donating a breeding to the PCCHA Stallion Service Auction; breeding must bring a minimum final bid of \$1,000 to make the stallion fully subscribed. If the breeding sells short of \$1,000 the stallion owner must pay the difference to meet the \$1,000 minimum requirement to make all foals eligible.
- d. If Stallion misses the PCCHA Stallion Service Auction, then he may be directly subscribe the stallion by paying 50% of the advertised stud fee for the breeding year or \$2,000, whichever is greater. Stallions must subscribe annually to make each foal crop eligible.
- e. Offspring by stallions that have been nominated for at least three consecutive years who become either sterile or die will automatically be eligible for the stakes purses without stallion owner having to pay a nomination fee. (This does not apply to stallions who are currently turning in a Breeding Report using frozen or other type stored semen or dna.)
- f. All stallions must have on file in the PCCHA office a copy of their registration papers and an 8x10 photograph for promotional purposes.

II. FEES AND RULES: SUBSCRIBED STALLION PROGRAM

1. Nomination Fee:

- a. All stallions may be subscribed at a fee based on the following Fee Nomination Schedule, fees due on due date of designated year for eligibility.

b. Important: Payment must be postmarked on or before stated due date. Any checks or funds deemed as NSF or worthless will not be accepted until at which time funds are available. Caution: this may run into the next scheduled payment.

III. PACIFIC COAST CUTTING STAKES

1. The Cutting Stakes shall be held in two separate divisions, open and non-professional during the PCCHA Futurity. The entry fee for the Cutting Stakes is to be paid by the owner of the eligible offspring per PCCHA payment schedule.
2. The purse monies in each Stakes shall be distributed as follows:
 - a. Twenty percent (20%) of all stallion nomination fees shall be deducted for advertising and operations. The balance of the stallion nomination fees each year shall become the purse for the event to be distributed as follows:
 - b. Eighty percent (80%) of the added money will go to the Cutting Stakes purse and Stallion and Mare Incentives. The purse shall be divided between the Open and Non-Professional divisions in direct proportion to the number of entries in each division.
 - c. Ten percent (10%) to stallion owner's purse. The owners of the stallions siring the winners of the Cutting Stakes will receive ten percent (10%) of the total stallion subscription fees to be divided between the open and non-professional division in direct proportion to the number of entries in each division. Two places shall be paid in both the open and nonprofessional divisions. Stallion owner's purse shall be paid to the person(s) who paid the nomination fee.
3. All advertising of nominated stallions must specify the year(s) in which said stallion has been nominated.
4. There will be no refunds for any reason whatsoever.
5. The Pacific Coast Cutting Horse Association reserves the right to cancel this event without notice at any time prior to the contest without liability. However, in such an event, said association shall return all stallion subscription fees to the subscribers.
6. These rules are subject to change by action of the Board of Directors of the Pacific Coast Cutting Horse Association.
7. Any violations of the provisions contained herein may result in the stallion owner being suspended from any and all Pacific Coast Cutting Horse Association activities at the discretion of the Board of Directors of the association. The decision of the Board of Directors shall be final in all matters.
8. No representations shall be made by the Pacific Coast Cutting Horse Association that payment other than the initial nomination fee shall be made by the stallion owners. Any guarantee as to subsequent payment shall be the sole responsibility of the stallion owner.
